Overland NZ offers the only overland adventure tours in New Zealand. With 23 amazing itineraries, you can choose anything from a 5 day holiday to a 30 day adventure. 'Aotearoa' is full of endless possibilities to discover; stunning, remote landscapes and unspoiled scenery, mountain ranges, lakes, glaciers, geothermal fields, volcanic deserts, vineyards and vast areas of green farmlands. With Overland NZ you have the chance to relax on beautiful beaches, hike in our National Parks, canoe on unforgettable rivers, taste some fabulous Kiwi wine or cruise through awesome Sounds. For the more adventurous; there is rafting, jet boating, skydiving, bungi jumping and mountain biking to name but a few. Our group sizes are kept small so you do not feel like 'just another tourist'. TRANSPORT AND ACCOMMODATION

We use 24 seat overland trucks which have been purpose built for our Overland NZ tours. These vehicles are different than the large coaches and buses and allow us to access parts of the country that these other vehicles may find difficult. On tour we remain relatively self sufficient with all our on board equipment; forward facing seats with seatbelts, 2 card playing / writing tables, a fridge/cooler box, stereo heaters, all necessary cooking equipment, dome tents and very comfortable sleeping mattresses. We also have mountain bikes for you to use while on tour with us. We use different forms of accommodation on tour – hotels, lodges, farm stays and of course, camping. The camp sites we use are either well established in central areas, or much more basic DOC sites and in areas of incredible beauty. The lodges and farm stays we stay in are all locally owned and operated and these stopovers give you the chance to meet real Kiwi's on their own turf. All hard top accommodation is based on Twin Share / Doubles unless circumstances dictate otherwise. The tents provided are 3 person, easy to erect dome tents for 2 people.

TOUR PRICE

Getting the most for your money is what we are about; we tell you up front what is and is not included so there are no hidden surprises along the way. Your Tour Price covers the general running of the Tour; all transport including the Cook Strait Ferry; meals - all meals whilst camping most other breakfasts and some lunches; accommodation as per itinerary - Hotels, Camping, Lodges and Farm stays. Some major highlights and excursions are also included ie Cape Reinga and 90 Mile Beach, a Maori Hangi, a Hawkes Bay Winery Tour, a Milford Sound Cruise and the "Bridge to Nowhere" jet boat and canoe excursion on the mystical Whanganui River.

Our 30 day Absolute NZ tour departs Auckland and travels north to the Bay of Islands and Cape Reinga, followed by time in Leigh and Goat Island. We then cross to the beautiful Coromandel Peninsula before travelling via Taupo to Rotorua. We enjoy the delights of Napier and Wellington before boarding the inter-island ferry crossing the Cook Strait. Kaikoura, Christchurch, the Southern Alps and Dunedin are next on our route before visiting Milford Sound, Queenstown and the rugged West Coast. We make our way to the top of the South Island where we spend time in Abel Tasman National Park and Nelson. Crossing back into the North Island we overnight at a remote Rangitikei River lodge, take a trip on the Whanganui River to the 'Bridge to Nowhere' and travel through the Tongariro National Park. Waitomo Caves and the mighty Waikato follow, before we make our way back to Auckland where this amazing tour ends.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

1. **YOUR SIGNATURE:** The person signing and or completing the Booking Form accepts these conditions on behalf of himself or herself and all other named persons on the Booking Form and represents that he or she is authorised to accept these conditions on behalf of such others. 2. **THE CONTRACT:** No contract shall exist between the Company and the Client until the Company has received the deposit and completed Booking Form, and the Company has confirmed the booking to the Client or the client's Travel Agent. 3. **PAYMENT:** The balance of the tour cost must be paid no later than four weeks prior to the departure date for all tours. Otherwise the company may treat the booking as being cancelled by the client. Bookings made within 8 weeks of departure must be paid in full. 4. **AMENDMENTS:** Changes or amendments to your booking will incur a \$50 charge per amendment. Any request received less than eight weeks before departure of the original booking will be treated as a cancellation and the applicable cancellation charges will apply. 5. **CANCELLATION BY THE CLIENT:** Should a Client wish to cancel a booking, the cancellation will take effect from the date the Company receives written notification. The applicable cancellation charges are as follows: 100% Tour Price. 6. **CANCELLATION BY THE COMPANY:** The Company reserves the right to cancel a tour in the event the minimum number of passengers specified is not met, or for any other reason determined by the company prior to departure. Clients must bear this in mind when booking non refundable or restricted flights and insurance as the company shall not be liable to compensate or refund any losses as a result of a tour cancellation. 7. **CONVEYANCE OF THE CLIENT:** The conveyance of the Client, his or her luggage and personal property during the tour by any carrier, other than the Company, is subject to the terms and conditions of such carrier, and if by the Company, these conditions.
